Eligibility & Media

- Open to artists residing in the U.S.
- Original 2D and 3D work in any media, including paintings, pulled prints, drawings, photography and digital images. Computer manipulated work and work done in a class environment are not allowed.
- 3D work limited to 60 lbs.
- All work must be original (*no reproductions*), produced within the last two years and not previously shown at the Customs House Museum

CD Submission Requirements

- Up to three works may be submitted as JPEGs on CD.
- Image should be at approximately 600x600 pixels, no larger than 1500x1500 pixels and saved as JPEGs at the highest quality setting.
- Title digital files with the artist's last name, first initial, and number corresponding to the entry form.
ie. Smith_A_1.jpeg
- All other information, title, size, medium, etc. to be mailed with CD on the hard copy entry form.
- CD should be clearly labeled with the artist's name.

- Notification of acceptance emailed March 23
- Hand Deliver to Museum on April 20th —21st from 10:00 am - 3:00 pm
- Shipped work to arrive between April 1—April 20
- Exhibition Opens May 10th
- Preview Reception May 11th, 6:00 - 8:00 pm
- Exhibition Closes August 5th
- Shipped work returned at by August 17th.
- Pick up Hand Delivered work, Aug 10th and 11th from 10:00 am - 3:00pm

Entry Fee

There is a (nonrefundable) \$30 entry fee for up to three submissions,. Entry by CD only.
CD's will not be returned. Make checks payable to **Customs House Museum.**

Awards

Cash awards, including purchase awards.

Insurance & Liability

Work will be insured at **the Customs House Museum while on premises** but not in transit. The museum will not assume responsibility for work improperly framed or poorly packaged for shipping.

Shipping

Shipping instructions will be sent to artists whose work has been accepted into the exhibition.

Juror: Alison Oakes. Oakes is a Knoxville native who received a bachelor's degree from CCAD in 2004. After completion of her first degree she returned to Knoxville and attended Graduate school at the University of Tennessee where she received her masters degree in 2009. Alison is currently an Adjunct Professor at Pellissippi State Community College, and also teaches in a new Arts Integration program in the Knox county school system called Arts 360. Alison has also taught in the KMA's summer art academy for 7yrs and various other grant programs through the KMA.
