

## Visitor Guidelines – Know Before You Go

The Customs House Museum & Cultural Center is excited to announce our reopening to the public! We are thrilled to open our doors again starting Tuesday, June 2, 2020! For the safety of our guests, we'll be opening at a 50% capacity. During your visit, we ask that you follow some basic guidelines in an effort to keep Museum guests and staff safe and healthy.

### New Museum Hours of Operation:

- Tuesdays – Fridays, 11 a.m. - 4 p.m.
  - Closed daily from 1 – 2 p.m. for sanitizing
  - Sundays, 1-4 p.m.
  - Closed Saturdays and Mondays
  - Explorers' Landing, Family Art Studio, Huff & Puff Express Model Trains and Coca-Cola Café will remain closed until further notice.

- Timed ticket admission purchases are strongly recommended and can be purchased online or by calling 931-648-5780 ext. 2039. Walk-in admission purchases can be made at Seasons: The Museum Store, however, while the Museum is operating under 50% capacity, we cannot guarantee availability of tickets.
  - Per Local Government Emergency Order #11, face coverings are required in the Museum for anyone ages 13 and up.
  - Museum Members continue to enjoy free daily admission, we strongly recommend you reserve your time on our website. Log in to your My Museum account for member pricing.
  - Arrive only during your reserved ticket time and with all the members of your party. Make sure everyone has a reserved ticket before arrival including small children.
  - If you have a fever or are showing any symptoms of COVID-19, please refrain from visiting the Museum.
  - Face masks or coverings are strongly recommended while in or around the premises.
  - For your safety, wash your hands often. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the Museum.
  - For your touch-free convenience you will have access to digital gallery guides. If this is not preferred, paper copies are available.
  - Waiting in the Lobby or Store is not permitted.
  - Food and drinks are strictly prohibited inside the Museum.
  - Please be attentive to signage in the Lobby and Store that provide guidance on safe entering, exiting and lining up at the register.
  - Maintain six-foot distances at all times between you and other Museum guests.
  - Limit any touching to only what is absolutely necessary. Touching art and artifacts on exhibit is never permitted.
